Next board meeting is scheduled for 7:30 p.m. Thursday, November 6 at the Beals' home.

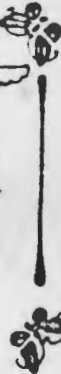
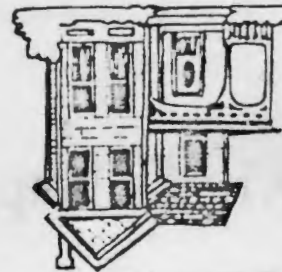
