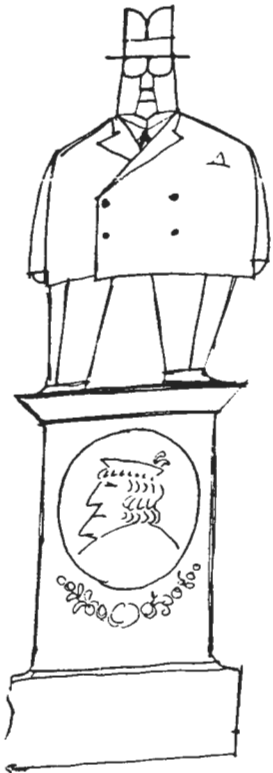
## SPEAKING OF PEOPLE
