Birdhouses will be on display throughout town from September 29th to October 3rd, and then moved to Chautauqua Hall for the silent auction. During this time the public will be encouraged to come by and see the always amazing entries and place a bid to purchase any of the entries. All bidding will close at 4:00 pm Sunday, October 6th. All proceeds go to the Heritage Society to help us carry our mission of keeping Pacific Grove what it is.

Our distinguished judge, Mayor Bill Peake, will be reviewing all entries and deciding on winners in each of the categories. Awards will be announced Saturday afternoon. Bidding will continue until 4:00 pm on Sunday. Those with winning bids can pay and pick up their birdhouse at that time
